Lamure Research Update

July 5, 2010

Introduction

As is the case in genealogy, the tracing of ancestors begins with two parents. These two parents also have two parents each, so it is obvious that the number of individual lineages increases rapidly and expands at a great rate with every generation. When considering Dorothy's lineage it was necessary (and prudent) to look at some of the other family lines, in addition to the Whiteduck line, as they are equally responsible for the genetic makeup of who Dorothy became. In this portion of our research we will deal with the family of Peter John Whiteduck's mother (Dorothy's paternal grandmother) Mary Ann Lamure.

Some information was contained in the portion entitled Whiteduck Research and we will not repeat it in its entirety. We will, however, repeat some details for the purpose of clarity and consistency.

It was also important to us, as we progressed with this undertaking, to be extremely vigilant of any records that tied the Whiteduck and Lamure families together. Due to the fact that the wedding record for Gabriel Whiteduck and Mary Lamure stated they had received a dispensation from the church for consanguinity (third to the second degree) we were confident that they shared a common ancestor.

Records and Family Details

From Ministry of Consumer and Commercial relations document Ref# 88-345953-1-06 Issued @ Toronto December 13, 1988:

Peter John Whiteduck was born July 22, 1923. Place of birth Rolph. Father's name Gabriel Whiteduck, place of birth Ontario, occupation farmer, age 44, address Rolph. Mother's name Mary Lamure, age 30.

Death certificate, Ontario, Canada D069295 90-016625-02:

Mary Whiteduck, date of death March 15, 1925, place of death Rolph, sex female, age 32, married, date of registration March 20, 1925, registration # 1925-05-028358.

Copy of marriage registration County of Renfrew, Division of Rolph, Buchanan and Wylie:

Name of groom Gabriel Whiteduck, name of bride Anna Mary Lamure, date of marriage July 14, 1920, by banns, place of marriage Wylie, County of Renfrew, married by Reverend French, Roman Catholic. Registered November 8, 1920.

Certificate of marriage, Ontario M236562 96-316156-03:

Copy of death registration for County of Renfrew, Division of Rolph, Buchanan and Wylie, Reg. # 027232:

Mary Whiteduck, Lot # 4, Concession B, township of Rolph, sex female, married, race Algonquin, age 32 years, Ontario, housewife, years lived at place of death 32, years lived in Ontario 32, years lived in Canada 32. Father's name John B. Lamure born Quebec, Mother's name Mary Pilon born Quebec. Informant Gabriel Whiteduck of Wylie, husband, March 17, 1925, Point Alexander. Cause of death tuberculosis.

From a letter to us from Jan Leroux dated October 23, 1996:

“Baptiste Lamure married to Mary Pilon shows in the Census record for 1871 in Pe-tawawa, 1881 Census in the Pontiac, as well as the 1901 Census in Griffith. I know that Jimmy Allen Lamure has conducted extensive research on the Lamure side of the family. You may want to contact him.”

From Jimmy Lamure’s letter of November 1996:

“I am sending [sic] you a copy of my family tree, and the Hogue family he was looking for Baptiste Lamure, and Mary Pilon.”

Along with his letter Jimmy faxed a copy of a picture of Baptiste Lamure and his wife Marie Pilon. On it, it is written *“Both spoke Indian-Algonquin tribe”*

This gave us not only the names of Dorothy’s great grandparents (Mary Lamure’s parents), but their photograph as well.

In late November 1996 Dorothy submitted her application for enrollment in the Land Claim Negotiation Process to the Algonquins of Golden Lake First Nation. We received acknowledgment of her application on November 26, 1996, and on December 2, 1996, we received confirmation she had been accepted for enrollment due to her ties to Joseph Lamure. Included in the correspondence from Helen Aubrey (Enrollment Clerk - Algonquins of Golden Lake First Nation) was a family tree showing the Lamure lineage back to Angus Lamure and his wife Margaret Leclaire¹, as well as the Pilon lineage back to Abraham Pilon and his wife Marie Josette Kakwabit. Copies of various censuses provided gave us additional information on the Pilon and Lamure families.

¹ This information regarding Angus Lamure and Margaret Leclaire has never been verified by us and we believe they are not the parents of Joseph Lamure. This will be discussed later.

We had sent two letters in late November to the Catholic Churches in both Chalk River and Deep River looking for information on Gabriel Whiteduck and Mary Lamure. On November 29, 1996, we received a letter from Reverend Bill Kenny, Our Lady of Good Counsel Parish in Deep River, with some information.

A copy of the parish register (Our Lady of Good Counsel Parish in Deep River):

“This fourteenth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and twenty, I the undersigned parish priest, after the banns of matrimony were twice published between Gabriel Whiteduck, son of Louis Whiteduck² and Mary Whiteduck of the parish of Griffith on the one part, and Mary Lamure daughter of age of Jean Baptiste Lamure and Mary Pilon of the parish of Wylie, on the other part, after having obtained a dispensation from Right Reverend P. T. Ryan for consanguinity third degree to the second, no objection being made nor other impediment discovered, received their mutual consent to matrimony and gave the bride the nuptial benediction in presence of (signed) Gabriel White Duck, Mary Lamure, Moses Lamure, Mary Jane Lukus and Frank L. French parish priest.”

It is important to note that in the record the priest declares there has been a dispensation from the church for consanguinity third degree to the second. This proves there was a blood relationship between Gabriel Whiteduck and family, and Mary Lamure and family.

Second copy from parish register (Our Lady of Good Counsel Parish in Deep River):

² Later evidence will show Gabriel's biological father was a man named Joseph Layet.

This 17th day of March 1928, we the undersigned blessed the body of Mary Lamure, wife of Gabriel Whiteduck who died Sunday 15th instant after six weeks illness, at the age of 28 years. The remains were afterwards interred in the cemetery here in the presence of Wm. McKee, Maxime Lamure and others.

From Medical Certificate of Death, County of Renfrew, Division of Rolph, Buchanan, Wylie:

- Mary Whiteduck, Lot # 4 Conc. B township of Rolph, female Algonquin, married, 32 years, born in Ontario, father's name John B. Lamure (born Quebec), mother's name Mary Pilon (born Quebec), Gabriel Whiteduck of Wylie, husband, buried in Point Alexander March 17, 1925, supposed to be tuberculosis, registered March 18, 1925.

Third copy from parish register (Our Lady of Good Counsel Parish in Deep River):

This fifth day of July, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, we the undersigned priest baptized Helen Rita, girl, born the third instant of the lawful marriage of Gabriel Whiteduck and Mary Lamure. The sponsors were David Pilon and his wife Catherine Budge. The ceremony was performed privately, the completion of the ritual being supplied on July 10 in Pt. Alexander Church.

Third copy from parish register (Our Lady of Good Counsel Parish in Deep River):

This fifth day of August one thousand nine hundred and twenty-three, we the undersigned priest baptized Peter John Zebedeus, son, born the twenty-seventh day of June, of the lawful marriage of Gabriel Whiteduck and Mary Lamure. The sponsors were J. B. Lamure and his wife Mary Pilon.

Some additional material dealing with events of other Lamure family members was also included.

From Affidavit of Marriage, Province of Ontario, District Nipissing, Municipality of Mattawa, September 5, 1908:

• Name of Groom David Lamure, age 31 years, normal residence MacKay, Ontario, Roman Catholic, name of bride Lizzie Buckshot age 26 years, normal residence MacKay, Ontario, Roman Catholic, intended place of marriage MacKay, Ontario, County of Renfrew, to be married by Reverend O. F. Paquette O.M.I., his postal address is listed as Mattawa, date of licence September 5, 1908, issued by Reverend N. Nilles of **Mattawa.**

From Catholic Church records, Pembroke:

Mary Lamure - On this twelfth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and ninety three, we the undersigned priest baptized Mary, daughter, born the tenth instant of the lawful marriage of Jean Baptiste Lamure and Mary Pilon. The sponsors were John Rothwell and Honora O'Shaugnessy. Signed John P. Donovan.

In the margin it is written, " Mary Lamure, Point Alexander, married at Wylie, Ont., July 14 to Gabriel Whiteduck before Moses Lamure and Mary Jane Lamure, Reverend D. G. Breen."

Jean Baptiste Lamure (son of Joseph Lamure and Angeniq Chicachiwanokwa) was born Abt. 1844, and died May 20, 1934 in Rolph Township. He married Mary Pilon on August 7, 1871 in Quebec, daughter of Abraham Pilon and Marie Josette Kakawabit.

Notes for Jean Baptiste Lamure:

Jean Baptiste Lamure was one of the first to build along the shores of Deep River.

He was born circa 1844 (according to age in burial record) or 1849 (according to 1881 census), (October 25, 1850 according to 1901 census, Rolph Township).

Marriage record indicated there was a third degree of consanguinity so they must have been related in some way.

Angeniq (also Angenique, Anjenik, Marie Angelic and Angelina) Chicachiwanokwa (also Tcikadjiwanokwe) was possibly a sister of Catherine Chipachawekwe and/or the sister of Marie Chipachiwanokwa, the mother of Catherine Hudson. Catherine Chi-

pachawekwe was the wife of Michael Ketchiwikapawitz whose son John was born March 27, 1858 in Pembroke, Ontario.

According to her age in her burial record she was born 1809. According to the 1871 census, Petawawa Township she was 55, born in 1816. According to 1881 census, she was born in 1824.

Sarah (Cecile) Lamure nee Pezemoatch (Mackey) - This 11 Jul 1924, we the undersigned blessed the body of Sarah Pizenwatch, wife of the late Joseph Lamure, who died at Mackey the 9th instant after an illness of several weeks of pneumonia at the age of seventy-four. The body was afterwards buried in the cemetery here in the presence of James Carey, John Beauchamp and others. Signed J. S. Grier P.P.

From Catholic Church Records of Mattawa:

Philomene Lamure - The 6 May 1895, we the undersigned have baptized at MacKay, Philomene born 28 Mar of the same year, legitimate daughter of Joseph Lamure of this mission and of Cecil Paul. The godfather was Maurice Sage and the godmother was Maggie Talon both of the mission of MacKay. They could not sign with us. Signed G. Bellemare O.M.I. * Note in margin states she married John McConnell in Deux Rivieres on 4 May 1915.

From Affidavit of Marriage, Province of Ontario, District of Nipissing 1915:

Philomene Lamure - Groom's name John McConnell, age 26, residence Deux Rivieres, place of birth Deux Rivieres, bachelor, labourer, Roman Catholic, name of father Alexander McConnell, name of mother Angelique Pesindawatc, bride's name Philomene Lamure, age 19, residence Deux Rivieres, place of birth Mackey, spinster, Roman Catholic, father's name Joseph Lamure, mother's name Cecile Pesindawatc. Married in Deux Rivieres May 31, 1915 by Rev. Chaput O.M.I., of Mattawa.

Conclusions, Questions & Suppositions

1. Most information on the Lamure lineage begins with Angus Lamure married to Margaret Leclair, however, we have never seen any records to corroborate that fact. Some circumstantial evidence points us to believe Joseph Lamure Sr. (married to Angélique Tchikadiwanokwe) might have been Joseph Pakwach-inini dit Pakons, the son of Francois Wabikekek and Marie Anne Pinessiwikijikokwe, Nipissings of the Lake of Two Mountains. We also believe that Angélique might have been Marie Angélique, born of the marriage of Joseph Pekasiketch and Cécile Panosimokwe, also Algonquins of the Lake of Two Mountains. The marriage record of Gabriel Whiteduck and Mary Lamure states there was a dispensation for consanguinity third degree to the second. That in itself indicates these two people did in fact share a common ancestor. As the Whiteduck research indicates Joseph Pekakasiketch and Cecile Panosimokwe were common to several lines that used the name Whiteduck (Pierre Wabichip, John Capwewitang/ Whiteduck, etceteras), it is plausible that is the connection referred to in their marriage record.

2. Although there are the familiar variations in the spelling of Angélique's last name (*Chicachiwanokwa*, *Chicachiwanokwe*, *Tikatowanokwe*) the phonetic spelling of "Tchikadiwanokwe" is reasonable.

3. Another point of interest that we believe bolsters the case for the identity of Joseph Lamure being the son of Francois Wabikekek stems from the name "Lamure" itself. The church records of Oka for the 9 Jun 1839 read, "Conditional baptism of Amable born last February of the marriage of François Wabikekek dit Namure and Marie Anne Pinessiwikijikokwe of this mission. Sponsors: Ignace Kotchinj and Susanne Okijeadiwanokwe." Wabikekek was said (dit) Namure and that might have easily been changed

or recorded as “Lamure”. It is important to note that the birth years for both Joseph and Angelique are consistent with the description of their ages at the time of their marriage. Nowhere in the church records of Oka did we find any mention of the name Lamure (other than Namure mentioned earlier), however we did find a burial record for a Francois Wapikekek in the Chapeau, or Ile Des Allumette records, which indicate there was an individual with the correct name, in the correct area, at the correct time. It would also account for the reason behind Francois Lamure stating his mother’s maiden name was Mary Whiteduck when he married Madeleine Natowessi in Mattawa in 1911 (see page 25 of this report). His mother’s maiden name would have been Marie (Mary) Angelique Tchikadjiwanokwe (possibly referred to as Whiteduck) daughter of Joseph Pekakasiketch (possibly known as Whiteduck) and Cecile Panosimokwe. Other than such a connection, we cannot understand why Francois Lamure would have stated his mother’s maiden name was “Whiteduck”. The following are transcriptions of relevant records from Oka:

1819

27 May Baptism of Joseph, aged 2 mos., son of François Wabikekek and Marie Anne Pinessiwikijikokwe, Nipissings of this mission. Sponsor: Joseph Ostokwa.

1824

5 June Baptism of Marie Angélique, born of the marriage of Joseph Pekasiketch and Cécile Panosimokwe, of this mission. Sponsors: Simon Wasekijik and Marie Angélique Wabikinikwe.

1839

9 June Conditional baptism of Amable born last February of the marriage of François Wabikekek dit Namure and Marie Anne Pinesiwikijikokwe of this mission. Sponsors: Ignace Kotchinj and Susanne Okjeiadjiwanokwe.

1839

29 July After the publication of one bann at the solemn mass of this mission and the dispensation of the other two as well as the impediment of the third degree of consanguinity, marriage of Joseph Pakwatch-inini dit Pakons, Nipissing and minor son of François Wabikekek dit Kaioko and Marie Anne Pinesiwikijikokwe of this mission who give their consent, and Marie Angélique, minor daughter of Joseph Pekakasiketch, Nipissing, and Cécile Panasimokwe, also of this mission who give their consent. Present: Amable Pakwakona, Ignace Chapwewitang and Basile Enweiasiketch.

1841

20 July Baptism of François born the 2nd of last January of the marriage of Joseph Pakwate-inini, Nipissing, and Marie Angélique Teikadjiwanokwe of this mission. Sponsors: François Wabikek and Cécile Pimasimokwe.

8 August Burial of François who died the day before aged 7 mos., son of Joseph Pakwate-inini, Nipissing, and Marie Angélique Teikadjiwanokwe of this mission. Witnesses: François Kaioko and Joseph Pekakasiketo.

1842

16 July Conditional baptism of François Xavier born today of the marriage of Joseph Pakwate-inini dit Pakans, Nipissing, and Marie Angélique Teikadjiwanokwe of this mission. Sponsors: François Edwidjikapawitc and Marie Angélique Wabikibikwe. Father absent.

1849

31 August Burial of François Xavier who died the day before aged 7 yrs., son of Joseph Pakwatinini and Marie Angélique Tcikadjiwanokwe of this mission. Witnesses: J. Baptiste Ockinikiji and Etienne Manjai.

4. When Andrew Green (or James Andrew Green) son of Mary Green was married, the maiden name of his mother was recorded in the Bonfield church documents as being Mary Whiteduck. Additional documents detailing the same event identify Andrew Green as being the son of Mary Green. She was born in Calabogie of John Green and Susan Lamure. Was this reference to the name Whiteduck indicative of some relationship such as that we note under the census information on page 50 of this report? Was Simon Whiteduck, the man lodging with the Green family, the father of the child Mary J.? Was this grand daughter raised as the daughter Mary (of John and Susan) and did she at some point tell her son Andrew Green the identity of his true father was a Whiteduck? Again, this seems to be a plausible explanation for what is otherwise a strange reference to the name Whiteduck.

5. The sponsors at the baptism of Catherine Lamure 14 Jan 1846, in Chapeau, were Pierre Minens and Catherine Sakabanokwe. Catherine Sakabanokwe was the daughter of Francois Wabikekek. A certificate of registration of death for Jennie Stoqua, #028967, born 22 Nov 1860, female Indian, widow, mother of William Stoqua of Golden Lake, dated 24 Feb 1933, lists her father as Peter Menes and states the maiden name of her mother was "Lamure". The 1901 census of Renfrew North lists William Stoqua as being the son of Louis Stoqua and his wife Jane. Louis Stoqua was married to Jane Menass according to the church record of his death. At

the marriage of John Green (son of Susan Lamure Green) in 1902 one of the witnesses was Louis Stoqua and he was described as being a cousin of the groom (see page 51 and 52 of this report).
