Introduction

The following is a compilation of records pertaining to the family known as Wabikwans/Wabicons/Wapikons/Wapikontz/Wapiwas/etceteras. It appears they were also later known as Fisher.

From Catholic Church Records of Oka, 1843:

29 August 1843, after the publication of one bann at the solemn mass of this mission and the dispensation of the other two as well as the impediment of the third or fourth degree of consanguinity, marriage of Michel Wabikwans of this mission, adult son of Louis Pensan and Angélique Minondakokwe who give their consent, and Catherine Ik-wewic or Anantchiadjiwanokwe, minor daughter of Ignace Inini who gives his consent and Susanne Kijiadjiwanokwe, Algonquins. Present: Amable Weonting and Amable Pakwakona.

From Catholic Church Records of Ile aux Allumettes, Chapeau, St. Alphonse, of Pontiac, Province of Quebec, 1859-1876:

Michael Wabiguans - St. Alphonse Allumette Island the 30 Oct 1864, we the under-signed priest of this mission have interred in the cemetery of this parish the body of Michel Wabiguans, husband of Catherine, who died the 25th at the age of 40 years (*Note by Randy - born circa 1824*). Were present J. B. Perrault and Xavier Dolbec who declared they could not sign. Signed O. Boucher Ptre.

From Catholic Church Records of Oka, 1830:

30 June 1830, Baptism of Marie Catherine, born the 26th of last January, in the hunting territory of the Algonquin, daughter of Ignace Kwetchinj or Inini and Marie Susanne Okijeyadjwanokwe of this mission. Sponsors: Amable Benjamin Desfond and Marie Catherine Kiweamokwe.

From Catholic Church Records of Oka, 1848:

3 May 1848, Baptism of Ignace, born the 10th of last December of the marriage of Michel Wabikwans and Catherine Ikwenwy, Algonquins of this mission. Sponsors: Charles Kapeia and Elizabeth Ijipaiatekokwe.

From Catholic Church Records of Portage du Fort of the Pontiac, 1851-1862:

Patrick Wabougance - The 23 Apr 1859, was baptized by us priests, Patrick, born the 3 Mar last, of the legitimate marriage of Michel Wabougance and of Catherine Aqu-wish¹. Godfather Patrick Fox and the godmother Suzanne Johnson, who could not sign with us.

From Catholic Church Records of Pembroke, 1879-1888:

Patrick Fisher and Mary Stoqua - The 7 Jan 1886, after the banns of marriage have been thrice published at the prone of our parish masses, between Patrick Fisher Wapikontz, son of age of Michael Fisher Wapikontz and Catherine Conatchens of Allumette Island on the one part, and Mary Stoqua, widow of Xavier Bernard of this parish on the other part. Whereas no impediment having been discovered, I, the undersigned duly authorized by His Lordship N. Z. Lorrain, Vicar Apostolic of Pontiac, received their mu-

tual consent to marriage in presence of Georges Payette and Catherine Moreway.

Signed Thos. P. Gagnon Ptre.

From Province of Ontario, Schedule B Marriages, County of Renfrew, Division of Town of Pembroke, Reg. #010385 (?):

Patrick Fisher and **Mary Stoqua** - His name Patrick Fisher, age 20, residence when married Pembroke, place of birth Allumette Island, bachelor, occupation shanty man, name of parents Michel and Catherine Fisher, her name Mary Stoqua, age 33, residence when married Pembroke, place of birth Pembroke, name of parents lists "widow of Xavier Bernard" and on separate line "Amable Stoqua". Witnesses George Payette of Pembroke and Catherine Marois of Fort William, date and place of marriage Pembroke, 7 Jan 1888, both Roman Catholic, married by Rev. Thos. C. Gagnon by banns.

From Catholic Church Records of Pembroke, 1879-1888:

John Fisher - On this 19 Mar 1887, I the undersigned baptized John born the 2 Mar 1887, of the lawful marriage of John Patrick Fisher and Mary Stoqua. The godfather was James Stoqua and the godmother Mary Ann Fisher. Signed Ant. Clermont P.S.

From Catholic Church Records of Pembroke, Register of Marriages, 1900-1907:

John Fisher and Philomene Baudry - Date July 30 1906, bridegroom's name John Fisher, age 19 years, residence when married Golden Lake, Ontario, place of birth Golden Lake, Ontario, occupation labourer, religion Roman Catholic, name's of parents Patrick Fisher and Mary Stoqua, bride's name Philomen Baudry, age 22 years, residence when married Pembroke, Ontario, place of birth Pembroke, Ontario, spinster, Roman Catholic, name's of parents Basil Baudry and Mary Eagleman, married by li-

cense and banns, dispensation of 2 banns and third to third degree of consanguinity by Right Reverend N. Z. Lorrain, signed by John Fischer and Philomen Beaudry, witnesses Alex Partridge of Golden Lake, Ontario, and Maggie Stoqua of Pembroke, Ontario. I certify the above named parties were married by me at Pembroke Cathedral in the County of Renfrew, this 30 Jul 1906, J. T. Warnock Ptre.

From the Catholic church records of Pembroke, 1915-1923:

Thomas William Fisher - This 28 Nov 1918, I the undersigned blessed the remains of Thomas William Fisher, aged 11 years, who died the 25 instant (25 Nov 1918), son of Jon Fisher and Philomen Beaudry. The body was afterwards buried in the presence of John Fisher and James Neville. Signed Z. Lorrain

From Catholic Church Records of Pembroke, 1889-1899:

Marie Louise Fisher - On this 4 Oct 1891, we the undersigned rector, baptized Marie Louise, daughter born the 26 Sept 1891, of the lawful marriage of Patrick Fisher and Mary Stoqua. The sponsors were Joseph Klott and Kate Minens. Signed Julien Doucet, Rector.

From Catholic Church records, Fort William, 1879:

Micen 8abikons (Wabicons) and Cecin Stokois - The 24 Sept 1879, having dispensed with three banns of marriage by us and according to powers granted us by His Lordship Msgr. Duhamel, Bishop of Ottawa, we have received the mutual consent of marriage between Micen Wabicons, son of majority of the late Micen and of Catherine on one part, and Cecin, minor daughter of Amable Stokois and of Marguerite, savages of the Riviere Noire. We have given them the nuptial benediction in the presence of Benjamin Leclerc and of Paul Chevalier. Signed J. M. Nedelec O. M. I.

From Catholic Church Records of Pembroke, 1879-1888:

Felix Michael Wapiquos - On this 31 July 1886, the body of Felix Michael, son of Michel Wapiquos and Sarah Stoqua, and who died the day before yesterday (29 Jun 1886) of diphtheria at the age of about eleven months was buried in the R.C. graveyard of this place in the presence of Mathew Stoqua and Amable Stoqua. Signed P. S. Dowdall.

From Catholic Church Records of Pembroke, Register of Marriages, 9 Aug 1909, p.p. 66:

Catherine Fisher and Frank Vanasse - His name Frank Vanasse, age 29, residence when married Pembroke, Ontario, place of birth Maniwaki, Quebec, bachelor, Roman Catholic, names of parents Augustin Vanasse and Theres Morin, bride's name Catherine Fisher, age 26, residence when married Pembroke, Ontario, place of birth Pembroke, spinster, Roman Catholic, names of parents Michael Fisher and Sarah Stoqua, dispensation of two banns and license, signed by Frank Venase and Katherine Fischer, names of witnesses Louis Lebeau of Pembroke and Florence Giroux of Pembroke. Certified as being married at Pembroke in the County of Renfrew the 16 Aug 1909, by J. Kimpton Pt.

From Province of Ontario, Schedule B Marriages, County of Renfrew, Division of Town of Pembroke, Reg. #018147, 1909:

Catherine Fisher and Frank Vanasse - Groom's name Francis Vanasse, occupation labourer, bachelor, 29 years of age, Roman Catholic, usual residence Pembroke, father's name Augustin Vanasse, occupation labourer, bride's name Catherine Fisher, spinster, age 26, Roman Catholic, usual residence Pembroke, father's name Michel

Fisher, father's occupation labourer, mother's maiden name Sarah Stoqua, date of marriage 16 Aug 1909, place of marriage Pembroke, County of Renfrew, clergyman John Kimpton, by banns, witnesses Louis Lebeau and Florence Giroux of Pembroke, date of registration 16 Aug 1909, person solemnizing marriage John Kimpton.

From Catholic Church Records of Pembroke:

Mrs. Frank Venasse (**Catherine Fisher**) - This 29 May 1935, I the undersigned priest, blessed the remains of Catherine Fisher, wife of Frank Venasse, who died at Golden Lake, the 26 instant (26 May 1935), aged 57 years. The body was afterwards buried in the presence of Maxime Coriveau, John Stoqua and many others. Signed W. P. Breen.

From Province of Ontario, Schedule "A" Births, Township of Pembroke, Reg. #028468, 1895-1896:

Daisy Jane Fisher - When born 21 Sep 1895, name Daisy Jane Fisher, female, father's name Michael Fisher, mother's maiden name Sarah Stoquois, father's occupation tanner, informant Michael Fisher, relationship father, residence Pembroke, Ontario, present at birth Mrs. Poff, registrar H. W. Perrett.

From Catholic Church Records of Pembroke, 1879-1888:

Lizie Fisher - On this 5 Jun 1887, we the undersigned baptized Lizie, born the 1 Jun 1887 of the lawful marriage of Michael Fisher and Sarah Stoqua of this parish. The sponsors were Patrick Fisher and Lizie Marois. Signed Julien Doucet Rector.

From Catholic Church Records of Pembroke, 1879-1888:

Mary Lizie Fisher - On this 29 Nov 1887, we the undersigned rector of this parish blessed the body of Mary Lizie, daughter of Michael Fisher and Mary Stoqua, who died

yesterday (28 Nov 1887) at the age of 5 months. The corpse was afterwards buried in the R. C.cemetery in the presence of Michael Fisher and Patrick Fisher. Signed Julien Doucet Rector.

From Catholic Church Records of Pembroke, 1889-1899:

Theresa Fisher - On this 8 Apr 1896, we the undersigned blessed the body of Theresa, aged seven months, who died on the 6 instant (6 Apr 1896), daughter of the lawful marriage of Michael Fisher and Sarah Stoqua. The remains were afterwards taken to the cemetery for burial in the spring in the presence of Anthony Stoqua. Signed J. J. McInerney. * *Note - buried in the spring (May) according to records of Pembroke Cathedral 1889-1899.*

From Catholic Church Records of Pembroke, 1900-1915:

Ellen Cicilia Fisher - This 2 Jun 1901, we the undersigned baptized Ellen Cicilia, born the 29 May of the lawful marriage of Michael Fisher and Cecelia Stoqua. The sponsors were William Descarries and Deline Robichon. Signed A. Nolin Ptre.

From Catholic Church Records of Pembroke, 1900-1915:

Ellen Cecilia Fisher - This 16 Apr 1908, we the undersigned priest, blessed the remains of Ellen Cecilia Fisher, daughter of Michael Fisher and Sarah Stoqua, She died on the 15 instant aged six years. The body was taken to the cemetery and buried in the presence of Michael Fisher and Onesime Corriveau. Signed P. J. Ponthiand Ptre.

From Catholic Church Records of Pembroke, 1879-1888:

Ignace Wapikoens and Margaret Pilon - On the 6 Nov 1886, after the banns of marriage had been published three times in the St. Columban's Church of Pembroke, between Ignace Wapikoens, son of age of Michel Wapkoens¹ and Catherine Cothens², of Fort William, on the one part, and Marguerite Pilon, minor daughter of Abraham Pilon and Josephete Kakaquae³ of Chalk River on the other part, and whereas no impediment was detected, and no objection made to the marriage of the above named parties; we the undersigned received their mutual consent of marriage and gave them the nuptial blessing in presence of Albert Pilon and Catherine Stephens. Signed Julien Doucet Ptre.

From Catholic Church Records of Pembroke, 1889-1899:

Margaret Kataga - On the 11 May 1890, we the undersigned priest, Curate of this parish, baptized in the Mission Chapel of Point Alexander, Margaret, daughter, born the 23 Apr 1890, of the lawful marriage of Ignace Kataga and Margaret Pilon. The sponsors

were Jean Baptiste Lamure and Mary Pilon. Pembroke May 12, 1890. Signed Patrick T. Ryan Priest and Curate.

Madelene Wapikonse - On this 11 Nov 1887, we the undersigned Curate of this parish baptized Madelene, born the 2 Nov 1887 of the lawful marriage of Ignace Wapikonse and Mary Pilon. The sponsors were Abraham Pilon and _____. Signed Bernard Ruman Ptre.

marriage of Ignace Wabukoinc, widower of the late Margaret Pilon of the township of Rolph on the one part; and Anastasie Payette dit St. Amour minor daughter of Jean Baptiste Payette dit St. Amour and Louise Vaillancourt, of the township of Petawawa, on the other part; and gave them the nuptial benediction in the presence of Jane Kwatchenc and Marie Payette dit St. Amour of Petawawa. Signed Patrick T. Ryan, Pt. Curate.

From Catholic Church Records of Pembroke, 1889-1899:

Joseph Wabignons - On the 4 May 1896, we the undersigned rector baptized Joseph, born the 26 Mar 1886, of the lawful marriage of Ignace Wabignons and Anastasie St. Amour. The sponsors were Ignace Fisher and Marie St. Amour. Signed E. A. Latulipe Ptre.

From Catholic Church Records of Pembroke, 1900-1915:

Marie Louise Cataga - This 25 Jul 1902, we the undersigned baptized Marie Louise, born the 9 Jun last of the lawful marriage of Ignace Cataga and Anastasie St. Amour. The sponsors were Ambroise St. Amour and Amanda Charlebois. Signed E. A. Latulipe Ptre.

From Catholic Church Records of Pembroke, 1889-1899:

Marie Emma Anastasie Kataga- On this 9 Sept 1898, we the undersigned baptized Marie Emma Anastasie, born on the 6 July last of the lawful marriage of Ignace Kataga and Anastasie St. Amour. The sponsors were Simon Monette and Elizabeth Marois. Signed E. A. Latulipe Ptre. *Notation in the register margins states, "Married 4 Aug 1914 to Alfred Belaire of St. Pierre of Fort Coulonge by Rev. E. Dagenais. Witnesses Alex Vaillancourt and Agnes Belaire. P. S. D. per W. P. Breen.*

From Catholic Church Records of the parish of St. Pierre, Fort Coulonge, 1914:

Emma Cataga and Alfred Belair - The 4 Aug 1914, after the publication of one bann, made at the prone of our parish, and having dispensed with the other two in virtue of powers granted by His Lordship Msgr. Narcisse Zephernn, bishop of Pembroke, and having also dispensed with consanguinity in the parental line collateral, of the second degree to the third degree, having found no other impediment or objection made, we the undersigned priest of St. Pierre, Fort Coulonge, have received the mutual consent to marriage between Alfred Belaire, son of majority, aged 26, of Joseph Belair and Victo-rine Vaillancourt on the one part, and Emma Cataga, minor child, living in Pembroke, age 17 years, of the late Ignace Cataga and Anastasie St. Amour of Pembroke on the other part and have given them the nuptial benediction in the presence of Alexandre Vaillancourt and Agnes Belair who could not sign with us. The boy signed with us.
Signed Alex Vaillancourt and J. Camille Dagenais Ptre.

From Catholic Church Records of Fort William 1863-1888:

Antoine Fisher - The 14 Sep 1874, we the undersigned priest have received the mutual consent to marriage between Antoine Fisher, widower of Mani Ki8egondo on one part, and Catherine, widow of Benjamin Mauroit on the other. No impediment having been presented we have given them the nuptial benediction in the presence of Joseph Lamure and Benjamin Leclerc who could not sign. Signed J. M. Nedelec O. M. I.

From Catholic Church Records of Pembroke, 1900-1915:

Antoine Fisher - This 5 May 1904, we the undersigned blessed the body of Antoine Fisher, husband of Catherine Coutchens. He died the day before yesterday (3 May 1904) and was buried in the presence of Robert Brindle and Cesarie Lem____? He was 67 years of age. Signed J. A. Latulipe Ptre.

From Catholic Church Records of Pembroke, 1889-1899: (See following census)

Robert Brindle and Catherine Morois - On this 13 Jul 1896, whereas a dispensation of two banns of marriage has been granted by the Rt. Rev. N. Z. Lorrain, Vicar Apostolic of Pontiac, and whereas after the publication of the other bann no impediment was found, nor objection made, we the undersigned priest received the mutual consent to marriage of Robert Brindle a resident of Mackey Station , son of age of the late James Brindle and Mary Ann McClary of Petawawa on one part, and Catherine Morois, widow of John Simon, daughter of Benjamin Morois and Catherine Coutchens Petawawa on

the other part, and gave them the nuptial blessing in the presence of Simon Monette and Elizabeth Morois. Signed Robert Brindle, Catherine fis Morois, Lizzie Morwa, J. J. McInerney. (*Benjamin Maurois, husband of Catherine Cogdchance¹, buried St. Columbkille in Pembroke, 8 Mar 1892, in presence of Baptiste Simon and Suzanne Squabanno*)

Ellen Catherine Wabicons - On this 12 Jul 1900, we the undersigned priest baptized Ellen Catherine born the 3 instant of the lawful marriage of Angus Wabikons and Catherine Michul. The sponsors were Andrew Fisher and Catherine Marois. Signed P. J. Tracy Ptre.

From Catholic Church Records of Pembroke, 1900-1915:

Ellen Catherine Wabicons - This 28 Jul 1900, we the undersigned priest blessed the remains of Ellen Catherine Fisher, daughter of Ignace Fisher and Catherine White-duck, who died on the 27 instant aged three weeks. The body was afterwards buried in the cemetery in the presence of J. J. Campeau and W. Beamish. Signed P. J. Tracy Ptre.

From Catholic Church Records of Pembroke, 1900-1915:

Ignace Fisher Kittigaw Wabigoosh - This 23 Mar 1911, we the undersigned priest blessed the remains of Kittigaw Wabigoosh, known also as Ignace Fisher, an Indian of

Petawawa, who died of pneumonia at the General Hospital here the 21 instant (21 Mar 1911) at the age of 65 years. The body was afterwards taken to the cemetery here and buried in the presence of Keon Simon and Edward Fisher. Signed H. C. Letang Pt.

From the Catholic church records of Mount St. Patrick:

Joseph Fisher - June 23, 1884, whereas the publication of the three banns of marriage has been made at the prone of our parish masses on Sundays the eighth, fifteenth, and twenty-second instant between Joseph Fisher, Indian of Mud Lake, son of age twenty-seven years, born in Admaston, son of Michael Fisher and Mary Cerres both deceased and of this parish on one part, and Mary Ann White Duck of this parish, minor daughter (seventeen years born in Madawatchan [sic]) of the late Simon White Duck and the late Therese Jacob of this parish on the other part; no impediment having been discovered. We the undersigned parish priest have received their mutual consent to marriage and given them the nuptial benediction in the presence of Jean Baptiste Kikykonse and Catherine White Duck both of Madawatchin [sic]. J. J. Collins P.P.

From Record of Death issued by Pastor Reverend John McElligot, 29 Oct 1997:

Mrs. Mary Fisher - This is to certify that Mrs. Mary Fisher born at Bonfield, Ontario, died at Bonfield, Ontario on 2 Sep 1929, and was buried with the rites of the Roman Catholic Church in Bonfield cemetery, as recorded in the burial records of this church, dated 29 Oct 1997 and signed by Rev.
